During World War II, thousands of pilots were trained at the Naval Air Station. Vero Beach also became the first spring training camp in the south. The Brooklyn Dodgers began spring training in 1948 where the naval base was located during World War II. In 1715, the Spanish Treasure Fleet wrecked off of the coast during a hurricane, giving it the name "The Treasure Coast" to the area. There were roughly 1,500 sailors who lost their life along with many artifacts. Silver and reminants from the ship wreck still wash ashore today! 
